They had physicians retiring but also new physicians coming in taking on retirees panels and new patients as well. Very few of their physicians have a permanent closed practice. Some clinics have on their websites notice of taking on new patients, some don't. It is often a simple matter of contacting clinics when an urgent need for a GP is brought forward without having to get into a formal mechanism that would require much work around privacy considerations and a dedicated staff person to maintain.</p> <p>Pathways: Division is just starting to work on getting Pathways setup, planning to launch by late September 2017.
